



WASHINGTON TOWN & COUNTRY FAIR 26th ANNUAL PARADE “CHEERS TO 90 YEARS” August 4th, 2019

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 2019 parade. Here are a few important things to know about the upcoming parade.

2019 COST OF ENTERING PARADE:

Non-profit groups: \$25 BEFORE June 21, \$75 AFTER June 21.

Businesses: \$100 BEFORE June 21, \$150 AFTER June 21.

Date of Parade: August 4, 2019

Tractor Trailer/Flat Bed Line Up: 2:00 p.m.

Entry Line Up: Starts at 2:30 p.m.

Time of Parade: 4:00 p.m.

Judging in Staging Area at 3:00 p.m.

Tram will pick up every 15 minutes: 2:30pm, 2:45pm, 3:00pm & 3:15pm

Mandatory Participant & Number Pick-Up Meeting: Thursday, July 18th @ 6:30 p.m. at the Farmers Market. A representative from your group **MUST ATTEND**. Groups not represented will be dropped from the parade! Please mark your calendar now to have someone attend.

To add to the quality of the parade, all participants are required to have decoration on their entries. Judging of floats will be based on the fair theme of “Cheers To 90 Years”.

As in the past, **NO POLITICAL ENTRIES OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PARADE**. Anyone displaying political propaganda will be asked to remove it. This includes clothing. If person does not comply, they will be removed from the parade. A complete copy of the rules are attached. Please read over them and review with your group prior to the parade.

Floats have the opportunity to be judged. If you would like your float to be judged please indicate this on the entry form. Prizes will be awarded as follows 1st place- \$225.00 & trophy, 2nd place- \$175.00 & trophy, and 3rd place- \$125.00 & trophy.

Judging will take place BEFORE the parade begins, at 3:00 p.m. in staging. Winners will be able to display their ribbons on their floats during the parade. Awards will be given out before the parade begins.

PARADE ROUTE

The parade begins at Circle and High Streets and will travel south on High Street to 5th Street. The parade will then travel east on 5th Street to Jefferson Street. On Jefferson, entries will travel north until reaching Main Street. The parade will end at Cedar and Main Streets where parade officials will direct entries down Front Street back to Fairgrounds.
