

2020 WASHINGTON TOWN & COUNTRY FAIR LIVESTOCK SHOW SCHEDULE

Wednesday, August 5th – Market Hog Show

- 7:00am-10:00am – Hogs arrive at the fairgrounds.
 - Veterinarian will be onsite to check hogs.
 - Hogs will be weighed as they come off the trailer. Exhibitor must be present when animal is being unloaded.
 - Hogs will be stalled per committee discretion after being weighed.
- 1:00pm – Show Begins
 - Classes will be arranged per weight as usual, 10 per class.
 - Upon exiting the ring, a photo/video will be taken by the Fair Staff with the exhibitor and their animal to be used for the auction.
 - The top two hogs from each class will stay for championship drive; others will be dismissed immediately.
 - Within an hour of completion of the show, all animals must be removed from the grounds.

Thursday, August 6th – Market Steer Show

- 7:00am-10:00am – Steers arrive at the fairgrounds.
 - Veterinarian will be onsite to check steers.
 - Steers will be weighed as they come off the trailer. Exhibitor must be present when animal is being unloaded.
 - Steers will be stalled per committee discretion after being weighed.
- 1:00pm – Show Begins
 - Classes will be arranged per weight as usual, 10 per class.
 - Before going into the ring, a photo/video will be taken by the Fair Staff with the exhibitor and their animal to be used for the auction.
 - As always, animals must be managed entirely by the exhibitor with safety as a priority, or animal will be dismissed from the grounds.
 - The top two steers from each class will stay for championship drive; others will be dismissed immediately from the west end of the barn.
 - Within an hour of completion of the show, all animals must be removed from the grounds.

Friday, August 7th – Market Lamb and Dairy Show

- 7:00am-9:00am – Animals arrive at the fairgrounds.
 - Veterinarian will be onsite to check lambs.
 - Lambs will be weighed as they come off the trailer. Exhibitor must be present when animal is being unloaded.
 - Lambs will be stalled per committee discretion after being weighed.
- 11:00am – Dairy Show Begins
 - Before going into the ring, a photo/video will be taken by the Fair Staff with the exhibitor and their animal to be used for the auction.
 - Animals will be dismissed immediately after the show.
- 1:00pm – Lamb Show Begins
 - Classes will be arranged per weight as usual, 10 per class.
 - Before going into the ring, a photo/video will be taken by the Fair Staff with the exhibitor and their animal to be used for the auction.
 - The top two animals from each class will stay for the championship drive; others will be dismissed immediately.

2020 WASHINGTON TOWN & COUNTRY FAIR LIVESTOCK SHOW INFORMATION

Livestock Rules and Regulations supplied in the 2020 Exhibitor Handbook apply with the following exceptions/additions.

- Livestock shows are not open to the public. Attendees should take personal responsibility for their own health and be aware and respectful of others. If you are sick or not feeling well please stay home.
- Each exhibitor will be given three wristbands at the gate. One to be worn by the exhibitor and the other two are for family members. Only those with wristbands will be allowed. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, no other spectators allowed.
- Exhibitors must register online by Wednesday, July 15, 2020.
- Stall fees will remain \$30.00.
- The exhibitor auction fee will be four percent (4%). One percent (1%) will be placed in the scholarship fund and three percent (3%) will be used to help cover show and auction expenses.
- No premiums will be given this year.
- Judges decision will be noted and recorded by committee.
- Club or exhibitor posters/banners will not be displayed this year.
- There will be no Traveling Herdsman award presented this year.
- No show boxes or tack will be allowed. Feed and water pans may be used.
- Exhibitor must be present when animal is being unloaded off trailer.
- A photo or short video of the exhibitor with their animal will be used to show at the auction on Saturday. Exhibitors do not need to prepare anything to say.
- Absolutely no outside coolers. Food and refreshments will be available for purchase.
- Truck and Trailer parking will be in the Motorsports Arena. All other vehicles will need to park in the Main Stage area.
- Exhibitors will be required to deliver their animal to the buyer's chosen processing location or to Dissen to be shipped.

2020 WASHINGTON TOWN & COUNTRY FAIR AUCTION INFORMATION

Saturday, August 8th – Livestock Auction at Washington Elks

- Doors open at 10:00am. Auction begins at Noon.
- Meal and Drinks will be served.
- Live auction attendance will be limited to those who have purchased animals the last 2 years.
- Two people will be admitted per buyer number.
- Virtual bidding will be available for bidders unable to attend event at Elks. Details will be e-mailed to exhibitors and published on the fair website by July 15, 2020.
- New buyers will be allowed, but will have to use the virtual bidding option.
- Exhibitors and parents will not be allowed at the auction due to the amount of space available and Covid-19 restrictions. They will be able to watch the auction live online. More details to come.
- Exhibitors and parents will be notified via e-mail after the auction with the results.

Sunday, August 9th – Shipped Animals

- All animals being shipped need to be taken to Dissen by the exhibitor. Times to be determined.
