The Fair Board is a group of volunteers that consists of no less than 22, and no more than 25 members. Below is a list of requirements and expectations for members of the Fair Board. **It is highly recommended that you have volunteered on a fair board committee for at least two (2) years prior to applying.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must meet the required age of twenty-one (21)
- Must agree to serve three (3) successive three (3) year terms (9 years total)
- Attend monthly meeting on the first Wednesday
- Attend committee meetings throughout year
- Include picture with application

EXPECTATIONS

- ❖ Present for fair set-up two (2) weeks prior to fair in the evening
- Present during day on Monday/Tuesday of fair week for final set-up
- Present every day of the fair for the entire day
- ❖ Present for tear down on Monday morning/afternoon following fair
- ❖ Participate in any Chamber activities that your schedule allows
