Applicant must also be a resident of Franklin or an adjoining county and must also be enrolled into a four-year college degree program, a two-year associate's degree program, or a one-year intensive technical program.

This scholarship will be awarded based on four criterion:

- participation as a livestock exhibitor at the Washington Town and Country Fair
- agricultural career plans as it relates to post-secondary education
- academic performance
- agricultural leadership and citizenship
